C&S Forms New Data Systems Unit Computing and Software, Inc., (C&S), a nationwide computer oriented services firm, has announced the formation of Data Systems Division. The new unit is headed by R. L. Christensen, Vice President, and is headquartered in the El Paso National Bank Building, El Paso, Texas. Christensen said C&S' Data Systems Division is primarily engaged in the supply of its services to customers who contract with outside organizations for data processing, data reduction, computer programming and computing equipment operation and maintenance. He explained that this type of business within DSD normally concerns itself with the supply of services within the customer's facility. The Texas headquartered division includes branch operations at NASA's Goddard Space Flight Center near Washington, D. C.; White Sands Missile Range and Holloman Air Force Base, New Mexico; NASA's Flight Research Center and the Air Force's Rocket Propulsion Laboratory, Edwards, California; and at NASA's Langley Research Center, Hampton, Virginia. Locally, C&S operates its Range Test Branch in support of the USA's White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico, This branch of the Data Systems Division provides data reduction, data analysis, systems development and maintains programming support, engineering and maintenance services, computer and electronic equipment operation, and related services in support of WSMR. This branch is headed by W. G. Holland. Computing and Software, Inc., is an outgrowth of one of the oldest computer - oriented service firms in the United States; having started its operations in 1947. Corporate headquarters are maintained at Panorama City, California and in addition to its Data Systems Division operations, other activities are maintained in the metropolitan areas of Los Angeles, Washington, D.C., and New York. C&S is a publicly held corporation and its stock is traded in the over - the - counter market.
